



## Linear Footage Worksheet

Measure the length on each wall in inches where cabinets will be. Add all the wall areas together to find the total in inches. Then, divide by 12 to calculate the total linear footage of the area. Round the total linear footage to the nearest  $\frac{1}{2}$  foot.
